PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE REPORT

1. PR26.030 REVIEW; of the parks opening and closing hours

The hours as most recently presented by the Parks and Recreation Commission were discussed and Rep. White says he agrees with the hours as presented, all other committee members did not. Rep. Giordano reminded us of all the opposition received last year. Rep. McDermott pointed out that maybe it is more of an enforcement issue, because the complaints were for noise. Conclusion being that some of the parks where complaints that we were made aware of, are not specified in the opening/closing time schedule. More research needs to be done with all parties involved.

2. PR26.033 REVIEW; of Tournament Fee Policy for use of city park fields onl r.

Giordano, advised the committee about some of the other cost these leagues have to pay. Therefore it is most important that we have an answer to the question. Rep.
