

## TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

The Transportation Committee met on Thursday Nov. 21, at 7:00PM in the Republican Caucus room. Present were committee members DeLuca, Mirkin, Giordano, Blackwell, Kernan and Zelinsky. Also present were Rep. Greenberg, Police Chief DeCarlo, Asst. Police Chief Lagan, Fedeli, MacWilliams, Palla and Poola of the Dept. of Operations, *and our President - Dave Martin.*

Item 1. T26.018 Proposed Ordinance; for Final Adoption & Public Hearing amending Sec. 231-5, providing the Board of Representatives authority over parking meter fees and times.

No one from the public was present, committee voted 5-0 for approval of the amendment-item is on consent.

Item 2. T.26.020 Resolution; amending Section 3.0 Hours of Operation, of the Park Square West Contract.

Glen MacWilliams indicated that by extending the hours to 4AM for the 24 part-time spaces at the Park Square West facility the city would earn approximately \$37,000. Glen stated that the Landlord has agreed to the change. Therefore, the committee voted 5-0 for the following amendment:


Section 3.0 Hours of Operation-(b)-1 shall read between the hours of 8AM to 4AM, this replaces the time of 8AM to 8PM.

Item 3. T26-01 Review; of pedestrian safety and pedestrian traffic patterns at the Transportation Center.

This item was put on the agenda at the request of Rep. Greenberg. Rep. Greenberg did an excellent job of providing the attendees with top rated photos of the problems existing at S. State St. and Station Place. Frank Fedeli indicated that the Metro North Police have sole control of enforcing activity at these locations. Fedeli stated that the project manager Brian Mercure has been cooperative in the past whenever requests for enforcement and control were made. A meeting will be set up with Fedeli, Rep. Greenberg, Chief DeCarlo and Brian Mercure. Everyone in attendance at the meeting agreed that this was the best way to handle the problems which exist, we are confident that the problems will be resolved to everyone's satisfaction.

Item 4. T26.022 Proposed Ordinance; for publication; amending Chapter 231-Residential Parking Permit Program.

The committee voted 5-0 for publication-item is on consent.
