

How Effective Is The Stamford Advocate In Publicizing Public Hearings and Upcoming Meetings?

- Public Notices Purchased in the Stamford Advocate Print Edition
 - Required by Charter
 - Cost: \$300 to over \$4,000 per notice depending on length
 - \$13,695 in fiscal 17/18 Expected to be much higher in 18/19 due to activity
- Public Notices Purchased in the Stamford Advocate Online Edition
 - Where are the online notices?
 - How does a person get to the notices?
- Should these notices be the sole outside medium to alert our constituents to key hearings and meetings?
- Notices are posted on our website.
- What else can/should be done to extend reach?
