Committee members discussed changing the resolution to not limit it to residents.

- The committee has been discussing applying the email list to residents in the past
- People who work in the City or businesses may want access to this information
- The Board of Representatives is elected to represent residents
- Business owners could provide email addresses to representatives under paragraph 4
- When the website is designed, there should be a way to distinguish residents from businesses

Committee members discussed proposed language changes.

A motion to amend the Resolution to a) delete the word "resident" from paragraph 2; b) change the words "Individual resident" to "collected" and add an apostrophe to the word "Individual" in paragraph 3; and c) change the word "residents" to "respondents", change the word "give" to "share" and "address to" to "addresses with" in paragraph 4 was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 4-1-1 (Reps. Matherne, Moore, Morson, and Zelinsky in favor; Rep. Nabel opposed; Rep. Lion abstaining).

Chair Lion adjourned the meeting at 6:33 p.m.
