## ORDINANCE NUMBER 1008 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 984 AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STAMFORD TO ADOPT A PUBLIC HEARING FEE FOR ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 8-1c of the Connecticut General Statutes authorizes any municipality by ordinance to establish a schedule of reasonable fees for the processing of applications by a municipal zoning commission, planning commission, combined planning and zoning commission, zoning board of appeals or inland wetlands commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the administrative costs of reviewing and processing Zoning Board of Appeals applications and holding Public Hearings in conjunction with certain applications has significantly increased; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to impose a public hearing fee on applications other than applications for variances to cover these costs; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the powers conferred by the Stamford Charter and Code of Ordinances and the Connecticut General Statutes and in accordance with Section 8-1c of the Connecticut General Statutes which authorizes any municipality by ordinance to establish a schedule of reasonable fees for processing applications and performing functions necessary to process said applications, the following fee is adopted as set forth herein:
