The Mission Statement was read by Seth. Amanda was the Facilitator and Nikhil was the Recorder. In School A, there are 2,100 students and 12 Counselors; in School B, there are 1,800 students and 10 Counselors; and in School C, there are 700 students and four Counselors. All schools have Bi-Lingual Counselors. Students who visit the Counselors are primarily high achieving students and students who are functioning on lower academic levels. Counselors share information on getting into college, but not the specifics of the offerings available in order to pursue a career. NAVIANCE supplements the information given by the Counselor. The offerings could be more individualized. There is a need for more Counselors with greater specialization with regard to what's available for students seeking higher education. The next meeting will take place on Wednesday, April 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. The topic will be The Attendance Policy.
