Total Cuts to the Operating Budget and Debt Service: \$673,805 (including the cut to the Parking Fund budget.

A motion to approve \$1,200,000 in cuts to the Board of Education Budget was made and seconded. After discussion this motion was amended to approve \$500,000 in cuts to the Board of Education Budget. Said motion was seconded and failed by a vote of 5-6-0 (Reps. Cerasoli, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli and Figueroa in favor; Reps. Di Costanzo, Coleman, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver opposed).

A motion to approve \$300,000 in cuts to the Board of Education Budget was made, seconded and failed by a vote of 5-6-0 (Reps. Cerasoli, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli and Figueroa in favor; Reps. Di Costanzo, Coleman, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver opposed).

A motion to approve a resolution adopting the Board of Education Budget, in the amount of \$292,426,654, was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 10-1-0 (Reps. Di Costanzo, Coleman, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli, Figueroa, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver in favor; Rep. Cerasoli opposed).

A motion to approve a resolution adopting the City Operating and Debt Service Budget, in the amount of \$530,334,020, was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Di Costanzo, Cerasoli, Coleman, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli, Figueroa, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver in favor).

A motion to approve a resolution adopting the E.G. Brennan Fund Budget, in the amount of \$1,355,939; the Grants Funded Program Fund, in the amount of \$10,387,340; the Police Extra Duty Fund in the amount of \$9,247,000; the Risk Management Fund, in the amount of \$13,795,993; the Marina Fund in the amount of \$370,012; the WPCA Fund, in the amount of \$25,838,165, the Parking Fund, in the amount of \$5,900,000 and the Harbor Management Commission Fund, in the amount of \$45,016, was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Di Costanzo, Cerasoli, Coleman, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli, Figueroa, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver in favor).

A motion to approve a resolution adopting the Capital Budget, in the amount of \$77,586,740, made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Di Costanzo, Cerasoli, Coleman, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli, Figueroa, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver in favor).

A motion to approve a resolution adopting the Capital Budget (WPCA), in the amount of \$18,775, was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Di Costanzo, Cerasoli, Coleman, Day, DeLuca, Fedeli, Figueroa, Miller, Mitchell, Quinones and Silver in favor).

Chair Di Costanzo noted that all of the budget numbers are subject to verification by OPM.

Chair Di Costanzo adjourned the meeting at 12:50 p.m.
