- We provide a safe and fun place for our members, including Friday & Saturday evening programming for middle schoolers and teens.

In 2017, we served over 1600 youth grades K-12.







Yerwood Center

- Over 400 K-3 children are enrolled in afterschool programs.
- Over 100 teens utilize the Yerwood Center in the evenings.
- Weekend programs include Stamford Youth Basketball programs, with over 800 participants.

Cost to run the Yerwood Center in FY 2018/2019: \$800,000

Cost to run the Mary C. Rich Clubhouse in FY 2018/2019: \$1.6 million

Budget Request

Total proposed budget for FY 2018/2019: \$2.4 million

- o \$1.6 to run the Mary C. Rich Clubhouse
- o \$800,000 to run the Yerwood Center

Request from City for FY 2018/2019: \$320,000 (13% of BGCS budget)

- o \$196,000 to run the Mary C. Rich Clubhouse
- o \$124,000 to run the Yerwood Center
