Strengths

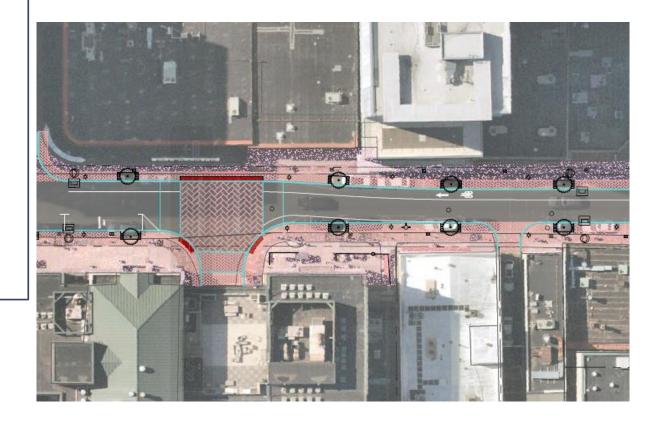
- Applied for over \$10 Million dollars in grant funding
- Aggressively planning and developing new projects and grants to capture new federal infrastructure funding
- Use of technology for day-to-day operations and asset management
- Implemented new community outreach tools
- Maintained high levels of service

Challenges

- 80% understaffed in Traffic Engineering Division which is the professional staff that manage the Department.
- Aging equipment
- Understaffed in Parking Enforcement
- Construction cost increases

ON THE ROAD AHEAD...

- Fully Staff Traffic Engineering Division
- Hire 2 Traffic Violations Officers to fully staff Parking Division
- Begin construction on the Greenwich/Pulaski
 Roundabout and Lower Summer Street
- Begin design on various grant funded capital projects
- Prepare for increased State and Federal Infrastructure Funding



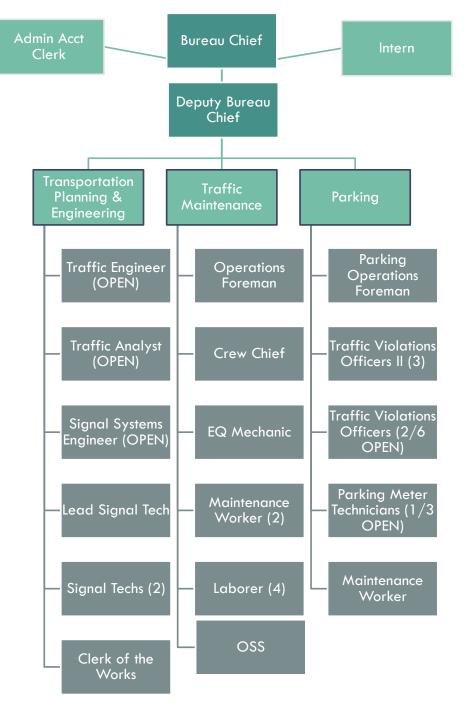






CURRENT STAFF

- Bureau Chief: Oversees Department functions and vision, project planning and development
- Deputy Bureau Chief: Manages day to day operations of department
- Admin Account Clerk: Manages department invoices, contracts, POs
- Intern: Assists Department personnel with various functions

Parking Operations

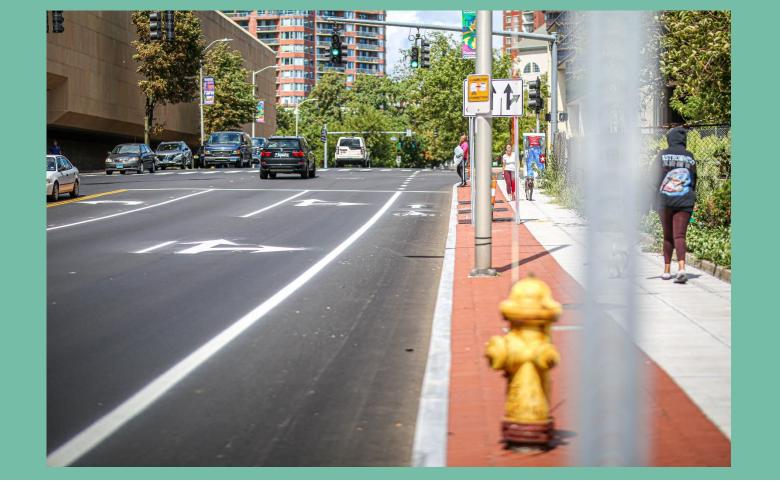
- Parking Operations Foreman:
 Manages day to day parking operations
- TVO II: 120 hr violations, scofflaws, general citations
- TVO: general parking citations
- Meter Tech: maintenance of 400+ parking meters and coin collection

Transportation Planning and Engineering

- Traffic Engineer (OPEN): Project design, development review, traffic engineering
- Traffic Analyst (OPEN): Data collection and analysis, grant writing
- Clerk of the Works: Construction oversight
- Signal Engineer (**OPEN**): Oversees City's 211
 Traffic Signals
- Lead Signal Technician: Manages day-to-day maintenance and operations of 211 traffic signals and various other signal equipment
- Signal Technician: Maintains 211 traffic signals, 50+ miles of Fiber cable, and various signal related equipment

Traffic Maintenance

- Operations Foreman: Manages day to day of Signs and Lines operations
- Crew Chief/Maintenance
 Workers/Labors: Installs and
 repairs signs, barricades, and
 pavement markings, parking lot
 maintenance, snow removal,
 special events
- Equipment Mechanic: Fabricates signs and permits for City
 Departments. Maintains small tools
- OSS: CBYD requests, invoices
