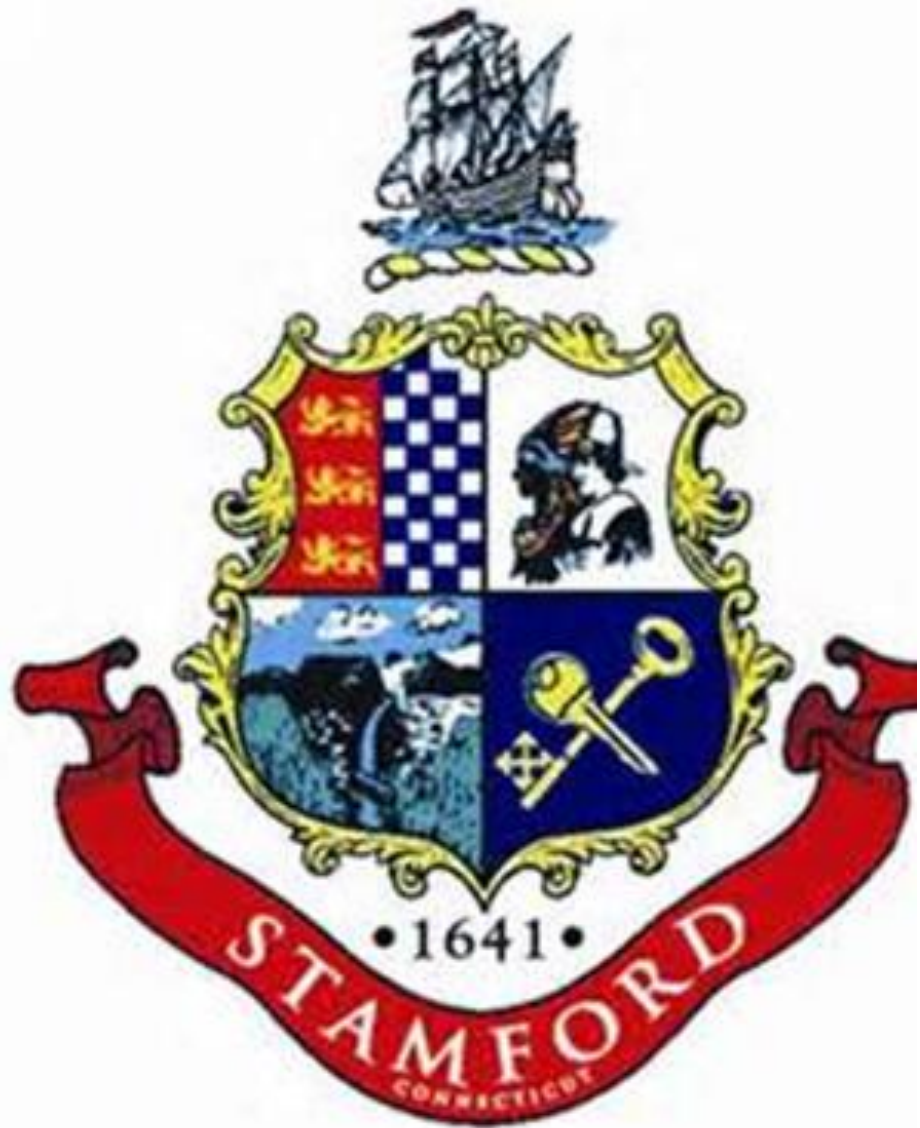


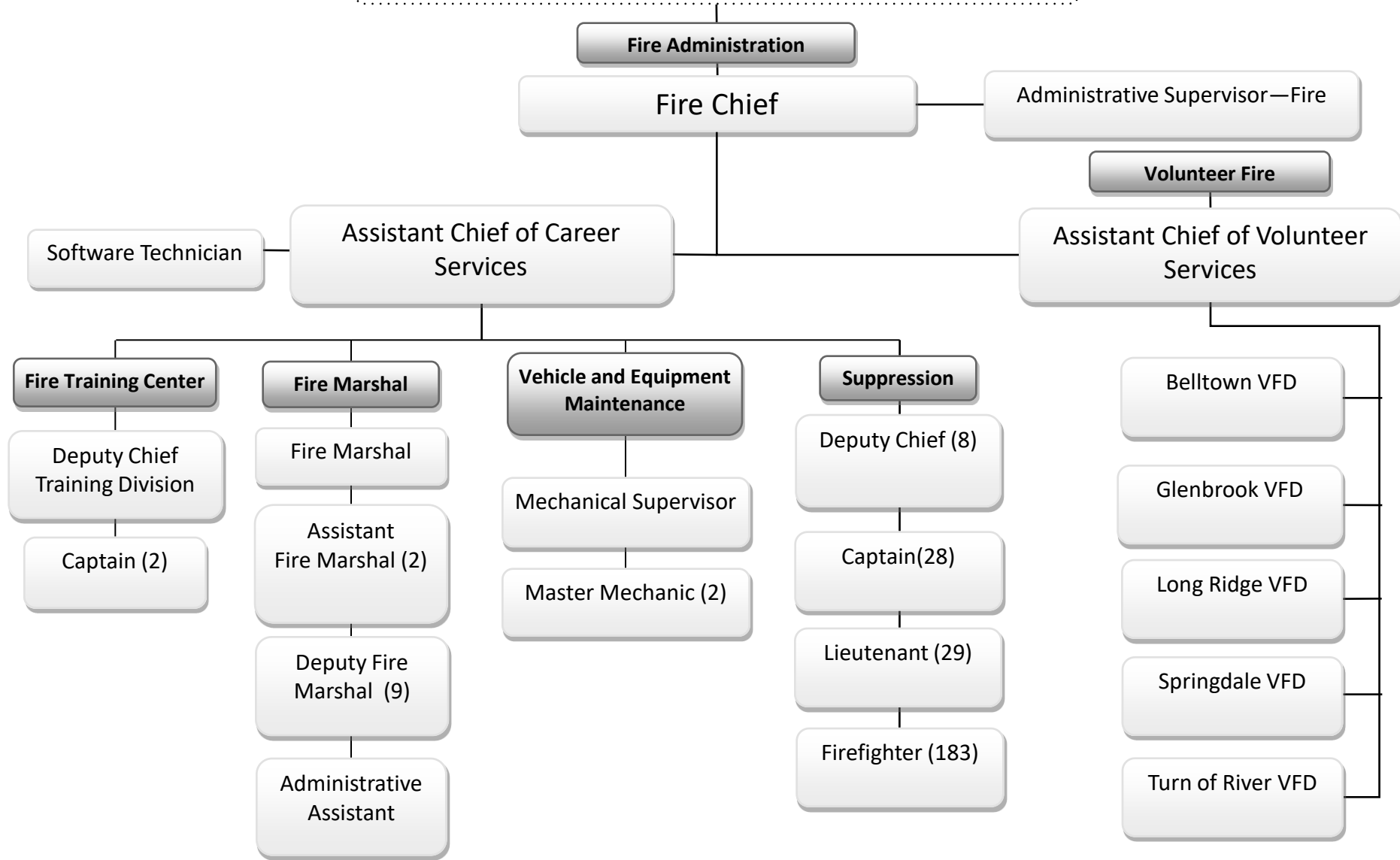

## Budget Summary (FY 2025-26)

- 5 % Increase in Volunteer Fire Departments
  - RMS Cost Increase \$4,000
  - New Timekeeping \$14k
  - Overtime increase based on current experience.
  - Electricity Increase \$33.4k
  - Gas Decrease \$6.1k
  - Training Increase \$60k
  - Facility Maintenance Increase \$20k

- Fire Apparatus Replacement \$3,050,000
  - Ongoing PPE Replacement per CBA \$225k
  - Truck Lift Replacement \$300k
  - SCBA Cylinder Replacement \$50k

## Key Challenges & Changes (FY 2025-26)

- Aging facilities requiring maintenance.
- New timekeeping software is required due to upgraded systems.
- Long lead times to purchase apparatus and parts.

## **Performance Improvements & Efficiencies:**

- New timekeeping software will be able to integrate with Oracle.
- Ongoing free smoke detector installs throughout the city.
- Improved protocols with the new incident commander.
- Continue radio upgrades. Allows multi-jurisdiction communications.
- Water mains and hydrants are still being improved in multiple parts of the city.
