Town Clerk Revenue 2023/2024

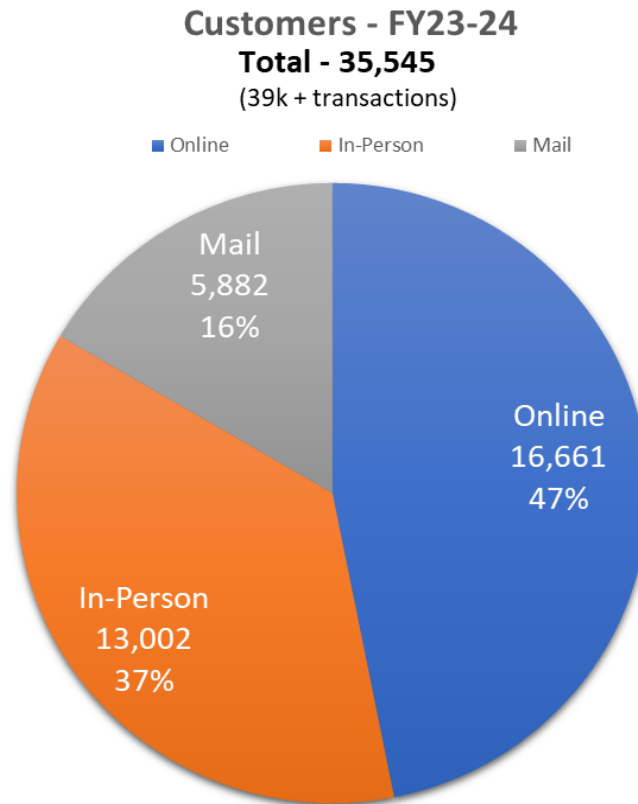
\$4.9 million – City Revenue

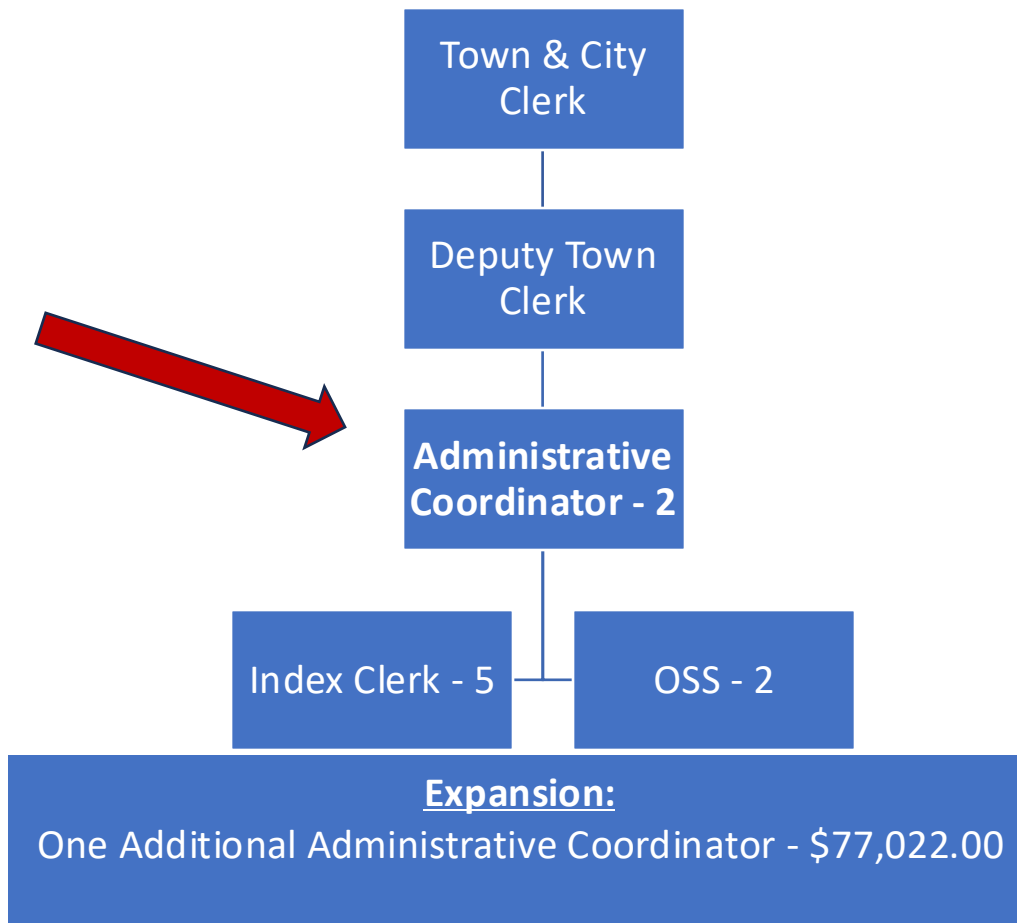
