
RESOLUTION NO. 3924 APPROVING A NEW ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR POLICE VEHICLES USED TO PROVIDE POLICE EXTRA DUTY SERVICES

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to charge a fee associated with police extra duty services to cover the cost of services;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Representatives hereby approves a fee of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per hour for each police vehicle that is assigned to a police extra duty assignment. Such fee shall be in addition to the existing extra duty administrative fee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this fee shall take effect on January 1, 2019.

This resolution was approved by a machine vote of 28-5-4 at the regular monthly meeting of the 30th Board of Representatives held on December 3, 2018.
