## RESOLUTION NO. 4028 AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL AND FILING WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION OF A TITLE VI PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF STAMFORD

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration requires that the City of Stamford file a Title VI Program;

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration requires that the City of Stamford receive the approval of the Stamford Board of Representatives for its Title VI program;

**WHEREAS**, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 provides that "no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance"

**WHEREAS**, the City of Stamford, as a recipient of federal financial assistance, will ensure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and related statutes and regulations in all City of Stamford programs and activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the 30th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford hereby approves the Title VI Program for the City of Stamford dated February 2020 and hereby attached to this resolution.
