RESOLUTION NO. 4096

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH
THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
FOR A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 FOR
THE LATHON-WIDER CENTER REPURPOSING PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 32-1 et seq., the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development is authorized to extend financial assistance for economic development projects; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the public interest that the City of Stamford to make an application to the State for One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$ 150,000.00) in order to undertake the Lathon Wider Center Site Repurposing Project (the "Project") and to execute an Assistance Agreement.

Martin is directed to execute and file such application with the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development, to provide such additional information, to execute such other documents as may be required, to execute an Assistance Agreement with the State of Connecticut for State financial assistance if such an agreement is offered, to execute any amendments, decisions, and revisions thereto, and to act as the authorized representative of the City of Stamford.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
