RESOLUTION NO. 4126 APPROVING A LIMIT FOR THE LOCAL SENIOR CITIZEN TAX RELIEF PROGRAM FOR REAL ESTATE TAXES ON THE GRAND LIST OF OCTOBER 1, 2021

WHEREAS, Chapter 220, Article IV of the Stamford City Code of Ordinances establishes a Senior Citizen Tax Relief Program; and

WHEREAS, Section 220-9-1(A) requires that the Board of Finance shall recommend to the Board of Representatives a limit for the total benefits under this senior citizen tax relief program; and

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2022, the Board of Finance recommended a limit of Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Section 220-9-1(B) requires that the Board of Representatives set a limit for the total benefits under this senior citizen tax relief program, which in no event shall exceed Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000.00); and


WHEREAS, on March 30, 2022, the Fiscal Committee of the Board of Representatives met and voted to establish a limit of Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000.00).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 31ST BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:

Pursuant to Section 220-9.1 of the Code of Ordinances, the limit for the Local Senior Citizen Tax Relief Program for real estate taxes on the Grand List of October 1, 2021, is set at Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,200,000.00)

This resolution was approved on the Consent Agenda at the regular monthly meeting of the 31st Board of Representatives held on April 4, 2022.
