AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN AGREEMENTS WITH THE CT DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY (DEMHS) FOR THE CITY OF STAMFORD - IMPLEMENT ENDPOINT DETECTION AND RESPONSE (XDR) PROJECT

I, David Hoak, do hereby certify that I am the City and Town Clerk of the City of Stamford, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Connecticut having its principal place of business at 888 Washington Boulevard Stamford, Connecticut, and that I am the keeper of the corporate records and seal. I also certify that the following is a true and correct copy of a resolution duly adopted and ratified by the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford on April 6, 2026 in accordance with the constituent charter of the City of Stamford and that the same has not in any way been modified, repealed or rescinded, but is in full force and effect.

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford has applied for and received a grant award through the Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DEMHS), utilizing federal funds provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), for the City of Stamford – Implement Endpoint Detection and Response (XDR) project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford approved the appropriation for this project at a regular meeting of its Board of Representatives on April 6, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Caroline Simmons, as Mayor of the City of Stamford, is authorized and directed to enter into, execute and deliver any and all agreements and ancillary documents on behalf of the City of Stamford and to do and perform all acts and things which she deems necessary or appropriate to carry out the terms of said grant and such agreements.

AND BE IT CERTIFIED that Caroline Simmons was elected Mayor, that her term of office began on December 1, 2025 and will continue until November 30, 2029, and that, as the Mayor, Caroline Simmons serves as the Chief Executive Officer for the City of Stamford and on April 6, 2026, has both the authority and the office to enter into agreements on behalf of the City of Stamford.
