In this case the properties were rehabilitated and sold by New Neighborhoods. The loan was repaid. The money was then returned to the State which increased the grant by 95% of what was returned. The City received 5% of the amount that was returned for administration of the grant. A motion to approve this item was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Ms. Emmett explained that there is confusion regarding the contingency. There are two relevant Charter provisions. C8-30-3 gives the Mayor the authority to propose a contingency appropriation in the operating budget relating to unforeseeable operating expenses. This provision has never been used. C8-30-10 permits the Board of Finance to include an amount in setting the mill rate, which is what is currently referred to as the contingency. It is essentially a revenue reserve to cover payment obligations for which no provision has been made or which the Board deems proper. This is not an

The State statute, CGS §7-348, confuses the matter further by calling it an "appropriation for a contingent fund."

Mr. Jankowski stated that there is a difference of about \$1.2 between this grant and the City grant due to benefit costs and the cost of outfitting firefighters with protective gear. (The grant has different terms than the City grant)
