PUBLIC HEARING - NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT

The Housing, Community Development, and Social Services Committee of the Stamford Board of Representatives will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, May 16, 2017 to qualify projects for inclusion in the 2017 Neighborhood Assistance Act. Each organization submitting an application must certify that it does not discriminate against any person or group of persons on the grounds of race, color, religious creed, age, marital status, national origin, ancestry, sex, intellectual disabilities, sexual orientation, or physical disability including, but not limited to, blindness, in the provision of services related to the program(s) under consideration for inclusion in the Neighborhood Assistance Act.
