This Ordinance amends Chapter 179, Peddlers, Street Vendors and Solicirins Ordinarice amends Chapter 173, Feducies, Steet Vehicles and Solicitors, Article IV, Mobile Street Vehicles to clarify that mobile food vending permits are obtained from the City of Stamford Cashiering and Permitting Department and that certificates of insurance shall be approved by the City of Stamford Risk Manager.
