A motion to eliminate the \$5,000.00 allocation to the Sickle Cell Disease Association as a cut to Public Services was made, seconded and failed by a vote of 1-3-1 (Rep. Uva in favor; Reps. Mitchell, Wallace and McNeil opposed, and Rep. Mahoney abstaining).

A motion to subtract \$1,613.00 from each of the allocations to the Sickle Cell Disease Association, the Yerwood Center, Inc. and NEON as a cut to Public Services was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 3-2-0 (Reps. Wallace, Mahoney and McNeil in favor; Reps. Mitchell and Uva opposed.)

A motion to subtract \$12,537.00 from the allocation to Pilgrim Towers, Inc. was made, seconded and failed by a vote of 2-2-1 (Reps. Mahoney and Uva in favor; Reps. Mitchell and Wallace opposed; Rep. McNeil abstaining.)

A motion to eliminate the allocation to Domus Kids, Inc. allocation of \$14,500.00 was made, seconded and failed by a vote 2-3-0.

A motion to subtract \$12,537 from the Public Improvements and Housing Categories, proportionately reducing each allocation by approximately 2%, was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Mitchell; Wallace, Mahoney, McNeil and Uva in favor.)

A motion to reduce the allocation to Administration & Planning by \$6452.00 was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote (Reps. Mitchell; Wallace, Mahoney, McNeil and Uva in favor.)
