Mr. Blessing reviewed the <u>attached Power Point presentation</u> with the Committee, reviewing the current BMR program and the proposed changes to the program, including the creation of the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

Items discussed include:

• Possible changes to the BMR program include

- Changing the formula for the fee-in-lieu program to a square footage based formula
- $\circ$  Having one list with one application, and one administrator (through an RFP process)
- The Affordable Housing Trust fund will be a single fund for all of the City's housing efforts using linkage fees, fee-in-lieu payments and other City funds
- The process will be transparent
- Funding decisions will be based upon a Stamford Affordable Housing Plan, which will be redone every 5 years

A motion to approve this ordinance for publication was made, seconded and approved by a vote of 5-0-0 (Reps. DePina, Wallace, Michelson, Moore and Roqueta in favor).
