This memo will confirm that you have elected not to sign the above-captioned ordinance pursuant to City of Stamford Charter Sec. C2-10-14, Ordinance Without Approval or Objections. It is our understanding this is the action you are taking despite your return of the ordinance to the Board Office unsigned. In accordance with the terms of the Charter, the ordinance will take effect 20 business days after its passage by the Board of Representatives. The language of the relevant Charter provision is below:

If any ordinance <u>shall not be returned</u> by the Mayor to the Clerk within ten (10) business days after it shall have been presented to the Mayor, the same shall be considered adopted without the Mayor's signature and shall become effective twenty (20) business days after its passage by the Board of Representatives, unless a different effective date is specified in the ordinance. At any time prior to the return of an ordinance by the Mayor, the Board may recall the same and reconsider its action thereon.
