SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDING CHAPTER 88 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, BUILDINGS, DEMOLITION OF

This ordinance amends Chapter 88 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances regarding the demolition of buildings, structures or parts thereof to incorporate within its provisions (1) revised notice provisions to enhance the notice to be provided to the general public of a requested demolition, as well as notice to adjoining property owners within three hundred (300) feet of any building, structure or part thereof, for which an application for demolition has been filed with the Building Official of the City of Stamford, (2) additional provisions for the protection of buildings, structures or parts thereof contained within the boundaries of any historic district which have been designated as an historic property, as contemplated by the provisions of Chapter 97a of the Connecticut General Statutes; and (3) enforcement provisions, including a \$500 fine or one year of Imprisonment for failure to abide by the provisions of the Ordinance,
