## RESOLUTION NO. 3682 APPROVING THE DEMOLITION OF THE CITY-OWNED STORAGE SHED AT SCOFIELDTOWN PARK PURSUANT TO SECTION 9-10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford is under a consent order by the State of Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to environmentally cap the Scofieldtown Park site at 612 Scofieldtown Road, and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed cap will go over the site of the storage shed in Scofieldtown Park; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Stamford to permit the demolition of the storage shed in Scofieldtown Park.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the 29<sup>th</sup> Board of Representatives, pursuant to Section 9-10.B of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the demolition of the storage shed located in the Scofieldtown Park site at 612 Scofieldtown Road.
