**RE: ACQUISITION OF RIGHTS OF WAY, TO INCLUDE PARTIAL
TAKING OF 4 PULASKI STREET FOR INTERSECTION
IMPROVEMENTS AT WASHINGTON BOULEVARD**

This Memo explains the request for Board approvals of the partial acquisition of 4 Pulaski Street, to comply with Charter Section C1-50-3 and Section 9-7.1 of the Code of Ordinances.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Pulaski Street @ Washington Boulevard Intersection Improvement Project will improve the turning radius for the eastbound approach of Pulaski Street onto the southbound Washington Boulevard travel lane to improve pedestrian and traffic safety, flow and operations in the project area. This requires relocation of an existing retaining wall along the southern curb of Pulaski Street and western curb of Washington Boulevard. Improved roadway section requires a full depth reconstruction of sidewalk, crosswalks and the roadway.

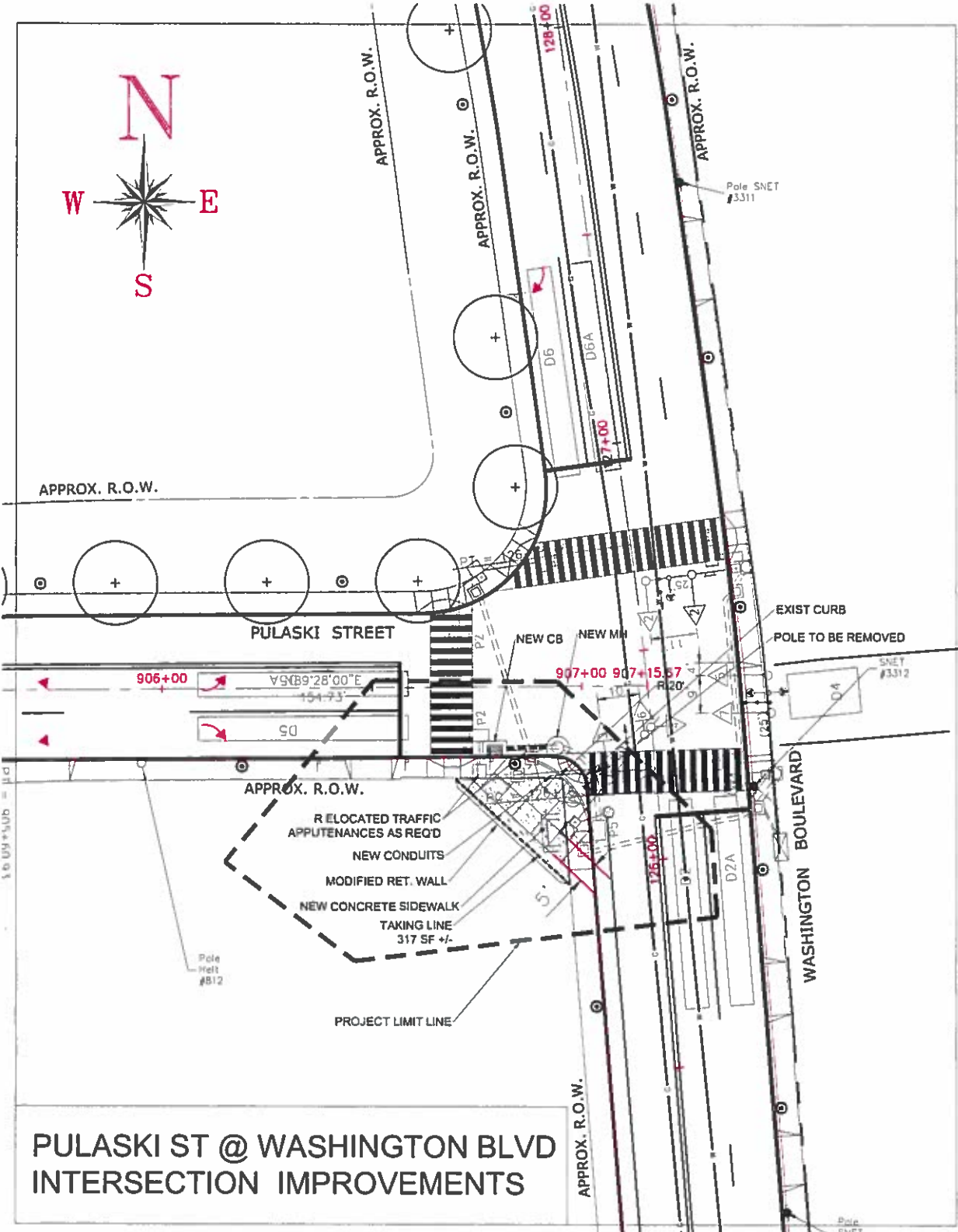
The existing roadway will remain open during the reconstruction of the project. All access to businesses and residential homes will be provided and maintained at all times.

PROJECT FUNDING:

The Harbor Point development will contribute all costs and execute construction of the project soon after the right-of-way is acquired by the city. Estimated construction cost is about \$80,000.

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

Final design will be completed soon after the right-of-way acquisition and the construction project will be completed by the Summer of 2015.
