
Re: High Ridge Park, Stamford, Connecticut

Dear Ms. Scott:

I represent High Ridge Real Estate Owner, LLC, owner of the corporate office park known as High Ridge Park in Stamford (the "Park"). We are in receipt of your letter to Jill Smyth, Executive Director of the Historic Neighborhood Preservation Program, dated July 3, 2017 confirming the State Historic Preservation Office's (SHPO) position that the Park is "eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places for its architectural significance." It is worth noting that the campus has undergone significant changes since its original construction, the most significant of which occurred at Building 6 which no longer remotely resembles the building originally constructed. I am writing to you now to express my client's strong opposition to the listing of any building in the Park on the State Register of Historic Places (the "State Register"), National Register of Historic Places (the "National Register") or any other local, state or national historic designation list or registry without its prior approval.

Pursuant to the Connecticut Freedom of Information Act §1-200 et seq., I kindly request any and all correspondence, materials, applications and other information regarding any proposed or pending application to include any building in the Park on the State Register or National Register or otherwise relating to the Park's historic significance. I further request to be personally notified of any application submitted in the future and/or any meeting or hearing regarding same. Please email any notification to me at the above referenced email address to ensure my prompt attention. Please also contact me when the documents are ready, and I will provide you with a check in the appropriate amount.
