RESOLUTION NO. 3941 APPROVING THE DEMOLITION OF THE EXISTING POLICE HEADQUARTERS, 805 BEDFORD STREET, STAMFORD, CT PURSUANT TO SECTION 9-10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, Section 9-10.B of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford states the Mayor shall request approval of demolition of an unused city-owned building or structure from the Planning Board, the Board of Finance and the Board of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, upon approval of the three boards, the Mayor shall direct the Director of Operations to apply for a demolition permit pursuant to Chapter 88 of the Code of the City of Stamford; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that the building is not feasible for renovations because a new headquarters is being built on an adjacent site; it is not cost effective to renovate due to the presence of hazardous materials; and it is not an historic property; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Stamford to permit the demolition of the existing police headquarters at 805 Bedford Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 30th Board of Representatives, pursuant to Section 9-10.B of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the demolition of the existing Police Headquarters at 805 Bedford Street.

This resolution is effective upon enactment.
