THE 'GROUP' WILL BE OPEN TO ALL. THERE ARE NO COSTS TO CITY & THE TAXPAYER. IN FACT, IF BOR APPROVES 'STUDY GROUP', IT ALLOWS CITY TO MAKE APPLICATION TO A FEDERAL PROGRAM IN 'NON-MATCHING' FEDERAL GRANT AID TO ASSIST IN THE PROCESS THROUGH CT HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE.

CITY IS AN AUTHORIZED CLG ('CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT') SINCE 2011.

TO BE PERFECTLY CLEAR - RESOLUTION IS NOT AN NRZ 'INITIATIVE' (NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION ZONE) - ALTHOUGH SOME MEMBERS ARE REPRESENTED IN THE AD HOC GROUP. THE NRZ IS A SEPARATE, INDEPENDENT COMMUNITY SPOKESPERSON FOR SO END NEEDS - ESTABLISHED TO COMMUNICATE TO CITY'S ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS. WE WELCOME NRZ SUPPORT.

THIS STUDY GROUP RESOLUTION HAS BEEN MADE 'PUBLIC' FOR 3 MONTHS THROUGH LUB & BOR.

THE 'AD HOC' GROUP IS COMPOSED OF COMMUNITY ACTIVISTS, CONCERNED RESIDENTS FOR PRESERVATION OF NEIGHBORHOOD, COMING TOGETHER OVER PAST 2 - 3 YEARS.. IT IS COMPRISED OF A MIX OF 'SO END' RESIDENTS & A STAMFORD URBAN PLANNER: 8 MEMBERS (5 REGULAR & 3 ALTERNATES) INTENDED TO BE CONSIDERED FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE 'STUDY GROUP'— THE STUDY GROUP WILL LOOK TO:

- INTERESTED PARTIES CONCERNED FOR THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OF SOUTH END-RESIDENTS, DEVELOPERS, LAND USE PLANNERS, ARCHITECTS, AND PROPERTY OWNERS. ETC CONCERNED FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION OF THE SOUTH END.
- THE STUDY GROUP DOES NOT MAKE NOR SUGGEST REGULATIONS OR CHANGES THE STUDY GROUP, IN FACT, SUPPORTS CURRENT MAP & ZONE REGULATIONS TO 2015 MASTER PLAN AND ITS STUDY WILL EVALUATE AND SUBSTANTIATE MP IMPLEMENTATION,
- THE STUDY GROUP GATHERS COMMENT, MAKES RECOMMENDATION BACK TO BOR
- THE RESOLUTION FOR 'STUDY' GROUP IS SUPPORTED BY <u>CT OFFICE OF HISTORIC</u>

 <u>PRESERVATION</u>; IT PUBLISHES A <u>HANDBOOK FOR HISTORIC COMMISSION</u> ON-LINE.
- STUDY GROUP INTENDS TO FOLLOW INFORMAL GUIDELINES OF ROBERTS RULES WITH A CHAIR; VICE CHAIR AND SECRETARY.
- RESOLUTION HAS BEEN REVIEWED_BY THE CITY'S LEGISLATIVE AND LAND USE BUREAU IT HAS CONFIRMED THIS DIRECT REFERRAL TO BOR.

STUDY GROUP BECOMES A 'RESOURCE' IN THE SOUTH END FOR INFORMATION, EDUCATION, & OPEN DIALOGUE FROM ALL, INCLUDING STAMFORD NEIGHBORHOODS.

- 1. STUDY GROUP FOLLOWS STATE REGULATIONS (CGS CHAPTER 97a SEC.7-147 <u>A K</u> WHICH ALLOWS FOR <u>SEVERAL</u>, HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSIONS <u>WITHIN</u> A CITY LIKE STAMFORD OR ANY CT CITY OR TOWN.
- 2. STAMFORD PRECEDENTS HAVE BEEN SET BY TWO BOR APPROVED HISTORIC COMMISSIONS: (1) IN <u>1984</u>-LONG RIDGE HISTORIC DISTRICT AND; (2) IN <u>2013</u>— HPAC (HISTORIC PRESERVATION 'ADVISORY' COMMISSION).

NOTE: SINCE <u>1986</u>, THE BOR HAS APPROVED THE SOUTH END TO BE PLACED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, NATIONAL PARK SERVICE <u>NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES</u>, WITH MAPS & INVENTORY OF HISTORIC HOMES AND BUILDINGS OUTLINED.

- 3. STUDY GROUP IS <u>'INCLUSIVE'</u> (ENCOURAGING CONTRIBUTION FROM ALL AND WILL FOLLOW NORMAL <u>CITY</u> LAND USE APPLICATION PROCEDURES/PROTOCOLS WITH PUBLIC & INFORMAL HEARINGS OUTLINED BY STATE'S ENABLING REGULATION.
