Over the years the town has approved an additional 700 residents without providing the necessary roadwork needed to insure smooth flowing traffic. There are times during the day, especially late afternoon for me, when I want to go downtown to the library, a movie or dinner, when it takes me over 30 minutes coming from Ardenwood at 1 Shore Rd., Stamford. I am a resident of Southfield Point and would like to enter my concerns regarding traffic in Waterside and have these comments distributed to the board.

Getting in and out of our neighborhood can frequently be a much longer ride than it should be due to the amount of traffic on Greenwich Avenue, Washington Blvd. and Pulaski Street, especially at the corner with the blinking lights at the exit to O&G. Getting out of the neighborhood during rush hour, morning or evening, can be disastrous and take up to 25 minutes for what should be a 5-7 minute ride. Once Charter Communications is actually up and running on Washington Blvd. it will get even worse.

We have been promised road improvements in Waterside for I don't know how long and they keep being held up. It is imperative to our community that these improvements be implemented, and I urge you and your colleagues to vote to allow negotiations with the owner of 21 Pulaski Street so that this can happen. This project is absolutely critical to traffic viability and pedestrian safety in Waterside.

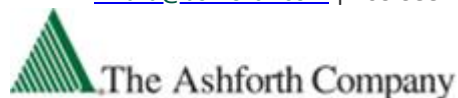
