Notice is hereby given that the Legislative & Rules Committee of the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford will hold a public hearing on Monday, November 24, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Democratic Caucus Room, 4th Floor, Government Center, 888 Washington Boulevard, to consider the following proposed resolution approving a purchase and sale agreement between the City of Stamford ("City" or "Seller") and The Housing Authority of the City of Stamford ("Buyer") for the Buyer's purchase of the discontinued Colahan Street, Stamford, CT. Anyone wishing to be heard is invited to attend and speak. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 29TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:

1. Pursuant to Sections C1-30-1 and C2-10-2(10) of the Stamford Charter, the sale by the City of the property of the discontinued Colahan Street to the Stamford Housing Authority for the sum of Seventy Four Thousand Dollars (\$74,000.00), is hereby approved, all as set forth in an Agreement for the purchase and sale of said premises, annexed hereto and made a part hereof.
2. The Mayor of the City of Stamford is hereby authorized and empowered to act for and on behalf of the City of Stamford, to execute and deliver all documents necessary to transfer title to such above described property, and to take all other actions and measures necessary to accomplish said property sale.
3. It is also resolved that any prior action taken by the Mayor with respect to this matter is approved.

This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of approval.
