**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE
APPENDING CHAPTER 201, ARTICLE 1,
REGULATION OF MUNICIPAL SEPARATE
STORM SEWER SYSTEM ["MS4"]**

This ordinance adds Chapter 201, Regulation of Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System ["MS4"] to provide for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Stamford through the regulation of non-stormwater discharges to the storm drainage system to the maximum extent practicable, as required by federal and state law. In particular, the Ordinance establishes methods for controlling the introduction of pollutants into the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) in order to comply with requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit process. The objectives of this Ordinance are:

- (1) To regulate the contribution of pollutants to MS4 by stormwater discharges by any user;
- (2) To prohibit and eliminate illegal connections and discharges to the MS4;
- (3) To give the City the authority to carry out all inspection, surveillance and monitoring procedures necessary to ensure compliance with the Ordinance; and
- (4) To ensure compliance with the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection ["DEEP"] Permit for the operation of the City's Municipal Storm Sewer System ["the Permit"], NPDES Permit No. CT 0030279, issued on June 4, 2013:

The ordinance is to take effect upon enactment.
