**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 29TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:**

Pursuant to Section C1-50-3 of the Stamford Charter and Section 9-7 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances, the lease agreement ("Lease") between the City of Stamford ("Lessor") and the Honorable James A. Himes ("Lessee") for office space on the 10th Floor of the Stamford Government Center, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Lease Agreement, which is incorporated herein by reference, for the period commencing January 3, 2015 and terminating on January 2, 2017, is hereby approved; and

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such Lease and to execute any instrument he deems necessary or desirable in connection with the execution of such Lease.

This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of approval.
