# Phillips dead

California prison officials said former NFL running back Lawrence Phillips was found dead in his prison cell, and they suspect suicide. Guards at Kern Valley State Prison found the 40-year-old Phillips unresponsive in his cell shortly after midnight Wednesday. He was pronounced dead about 1:30 a.m. He had been in segregation since April 2013 after he was suspected of killing his cellmate. ... Sportscaster Jim Simpson died in Scottsdale, Ariz., after a short illness. He was 88. Simpson worked for NBC, ABC, CBS and TNT, and when he joined ESPN in 1979, he gave the fledgling cable sports network instant credibility. In 1998, Simpson received the Lifetime Achievement Award at the Sports Emmy Awards.

#### SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 111 PUBLIC SAFETY AND ANIMAL WELFARE

This ordinance substantially amends Chapter 111. Significant amendments are as follows:

- 1) to add procedures regarding the surrender of stray dogs to the Stamford Animal Control and Care Center concerning stray dogs;
- to add provisions regarding the control of vicious dogs;
- 3) to add provisions regarding stray and feral cats and feral cat colonies;
- 4) to add provisions regarding rabbits, ferrets and other small pets;
- 5) to add provisions regarding the operations of the Stamford Animal
- to require dog owners to obtain a dog license, and vaccinate dogs for rabies and vaccinate dogs up to one year for parvovirus;
- 7) to require cat owners to vaccinate their pets for rables;
- 8) to prohibit the sale of animals on public property other than by animal welfare groups displaying animals for adoption;
- to add provisions regarding the breeding of dogs; and
- 10) to provide for various permit fees and fines and to provide that the Chapter may be enforced through the civil citation process.

The ordinance is to take effect upon enactment.
