SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL PROVIDING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR **SCHOOL RELATED PROJECTS**

This ordinance adds Chapter 23, Finances, Article VIII to the Code of Ordinances, creating a special revenue fund for capital projects related to the construction and maintenance of City of Stamford school facilities (the "School-Related Capital Projects Fund"). Funds appropriated into the School-Related Capital Projects Fund", Funds appropriated into the School-Related Capital Projects Fund may be used, at the request of the Mayor, solely to finance duly authorized long-term capital projects for the Board of Education of the City of Stamford in excess of ten percent (10%) of the proposed capital projects budget of the Board of Education of the City of Stamford for the prior fiscal year. Approval of such request shall require (i) the affirmative vote of four members of the Board of Finance, and (ii) the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present at a meeting of the Board of Representatives.
