**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE  
ADDING CHAPTER 183 CONCERNING THE  
USE AND SALE OF POLYSTYRENE PRODUCTS**

This Ordinance adds Chapter 183, Polystyrene Products, Use and Sale of, to the Code of Ordinances to prohibiting the sale, provision or distribution of Polystyrene products by Food Packagers and Retail Establishments in the City of Stamford. This prohibition shall not apply to 1) Polystyrene Food Service Products used for prepackaged food that a) have been filled and sealed prior to receipt by the Retail Establishment; b) contain or store raw meat or seafood sold from a butcher case or similar retail appliance; 2) Polystyrene coolers and ice chests, if the Polystyrene is fully encased in another material; or 3) Polystyrene Food Service Products or Polystyrene Loose Fill Packaging that are sealed prior to receipt by the Retail Establishment.

This ordinance shall be enforced by the Civil Citation Process, with a warning notice for the first violation, a penalty of \$150.00 for the second violation and a penalty of \$250.00 for each subsequent violation.

The ordinance shall become effective six months after its effective date, except that it shall not apply to Stamford Public Schools prior to January 1, 2023.
