PROVIDING FOR THE REQULATION OF EXTERIOR LIGHTING IN THE CITY OF STAMFORD

This ordinance adds Chapter 155, Lighting, to the Code of Ordinances. This ordinance shall be enforced by the Building Department, and if a violation is not corrected within 30 days of a notice of violation, a fine of \$100 per day for single-family, two-family, or three family buildings or \$100 per Luminaire per day for other properties shall be imposed.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE CONCERNING SINGLE-USE PLASTIC STRAWS AND STIRRERS BY FOOD OR BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS

This ordinance adds a new Chapter to the Code or Ordinancea prohibiting 1) the sale or distribution of single-use plastic stirrers and 2) the sale or distribution of single-use plastic straws by food or beverage in the city of Stamford unless requested by a consumer. This ordinance shall not apply to prepackaged and sealed food or beverages.

This ordinance shall be enforced through the civil citation process, with no penalty imposed for an initial violation, a penalty of \$150 for a second violation, and a penalty of \$250 for a third violation
