**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL
CONCERNING A TAX ABATEMENT AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY
OF STAMFORD AND LHT 4 LIMITED PARTNERSHIP
AND THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD
FOR 34 BELOW-MARKET UNITS LOCATED AT
31-97 CUSTER STREET (ODD NUMBERS ONLY), STAMFORD, CT**

This ordinance grants an abatement of one hundred percent (100%) of all real property taxes assessed by the City against the thirty-four Below-Market Units located at 31-97 Custer Street (odd numbers only), Stamford, CT, in accordance with the terms of the proposed tax abatement agreement and authorizes the Mayor to act on behalf of the City of Stamford, to execute and deliver all documents he deems necessary or desirable.

This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
