

Since the closure of Trailblazers Academy in 2019, Domus continues to use the building at 83 Lockwood Avenue to provide programs and services to some of the community's most disengaged and disconnected young people. In addition to our programs and services outlined below, we also co-locate other non-profit organizations in our building, free of charge. The one entity that we are currently charging for use of space is the Eagles Soccer Academy, we do this in order to reimburse for the cost of our staff when the gym is being rented.

Domus Programs and Services

- Drop In Center – Open daily from 12 – 9 pm for middle and high school youth to come and get help with homework, have recreation time, skill building, participate in workshops and more
- Alternate Education Site – Open daily during school hours for any Domus youth who has been suspended in or out of school to get assistance with their work.
- Open Gym – Wednesday and Friday evenings from 6:00 – 9:00 pm for all youth/young adult community members
- Work and Learn Day and After School Classes
- Community Garden – fully operational community garden taken care of by Domus youth/staff, vegetable shared with students to take home
- Clothing Distribution Center – Tuesday mornings community members can come and shop for free from clothing and outerwear items
- Holiday Mall – Provided gifts, gift cards, food and food cards to over 50 community families (non Domus participants)

Person to Person

- Tuesday and Wednesdays - food distribution site

Literacy Volunteers

- Registration and book pick up site
- In person classes (when they can safely resume)

Adult Ed

- Daily Adult Ed classes from 9:00 – 1:00 pm

Narcotics Anonymous

- Saturdays 6:30 – 8:30 pm

Eagles Soccer Academy

- Saturday mornings – youth soccer
- Sunday morning/afternoon – community adults

Community Volleyball (weather permitting)

- Friday evenings in the parking lot during fall, spring, summer

COVID Response

Vaccination/Testing Site

- Served as a vaccination site for the City
- Served as a testing site for various partners

Food Distribution

- Served as the highest traffic lunch SPS Grab and Go site during school closure staffed by Domus
- Provided food/necessity bags to 250 families once a week for 4 months with funds privately raised

Camp

- Housed summer camp for community 130 kids summer of 2020 so parents could go back to work
- Remained open for student support during the remote days and hybrid instruction days for students and their siblings, providing meals, wifi and access to computers until school resumed in full

Stamford Youth Spartans Football

- Stores football equipment in the building free of charge
- Runs equipment distribution and collection for fall season
