SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 220, TAXATION, ARTICLE IV, SENIOR CITIZEN TAX ABATEMENT

This ordinance amends the current program of tax relief to senior citizens who meet certain criteria to increase the income limits for eligibility for a tax abatement and to increase the amount of such abatement as set forth below; increases the limit of total benefits under the program from \$2 million to \$2.2 million; and permits filling of an
