If the second low bidder does not submit the required DBE forms within the required time, they will not be eligible for contract award.

CONTRACTORS that find discrepancies and/or errors in or between plans, specifications, quantities and other matters, must immediately notify the Purchasing Department in writing not less than ten days before the scheduled bid opening.

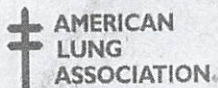
The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents she deems necessary or desirable in connection with the sale generally described herein.

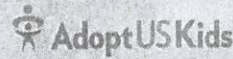
