## ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_ CONCERNING THE DECLARATION OF JUNETEENTH AS A HOLIDAY

**WHEREAS**, on June 19<sup>th</sup>, 1865, the last enslaved African people in the United States were freed; and

WHEREAS, it is important that such a momentous day be remembered; and

**THEREFORE**, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to declare that June 19<sup>th</sup> of each year shall be a City holiday known as "Juneteenth."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT** Chapter 37 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances be added as follows:

Sec. 37-1. – Declaration of holiday.

The 19<sup>th</sup> of June of each year is declared a legal holiday in the city of Stamford, and only those city personnel actually necessary to maintain the good order of the city shall work on that day. If the 19<sup>th</sup> of June falls on a weekend, the holiday shall be celebrated on the following Monday.

Sec. 37-2. When effective.

This chapter shall take effect on adoption and shall be observed yearly.
