**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE
CONCERNING THE DECLARATION OF JUNETEENTH AS A HOLIDAY**

This ordinance amends the City of Stamford Code of Ordinances to add a new section 37, declaring that June 19th of each year is a legal holiday in the City of Stamford, and that only those city personnel necessary to maintain the good order of the city shall work on that day. If June 19th falls on a weekend, the holiday shall be celebrated on the following Monday.

This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
