

**ORDINANCE NO. 1298 SUPPLEMENTAL  
AMENDING SECTIONS 37-1 AND 47-37**

**WHEREAS**, on January 3, 2023, the Board of Representatives approved Ordinance Number 1290 Supplemental concerning the Declaration of Juneteenth as a holiday; and

**WHEREAS**, it has come to light that Section 37-1, approved as part of Ordinance Number 1290 Supplemental, contains language concerning when the holiday should be celebrated if it falls on a weekend, which language is different from the language in Section 47-37 of the City Code concerning the same subject matter; and

**WHEREAS**, it has come to light that Section 47-37 of the City Code contains a scrivener's error; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford to amend Sections 37-1 and 47-37 of the City Code to correct the above-referenced inconsistency and scrivener's error.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT** Section 37 -1 and Section 47-37 be amended as follows:

**Sec. 37-1. Declaration of holiday.**

The 19<sup>th</sup> of June of each year is declared a legal holiday in the City of Stamford, and only those city personnel actually necessary to maintain the good order of the city shall work on that day. If the 19<sup>th</sup> of June falls on a weekend, the holiday shall be celebrated on the following Monday. Saturday, the holiday shall be celebrated on the preceding day. If the 19<sup>th</sup> of June falls on a Sunday, the holiday shall be celebrated on the following Monday.

**Sec. 47-37. Holidays.**

The following shall be paid holidays:

New Year's Day	Labor Day
Martin Luther King Day*	Columbus Day*
President's Day*	Veteran's Day*
Good Friday*	Thanksgiving Day
Memorial Day	Day after Thanksgiving Day
<u>Juneteenth</u>	Christmas Eve after 12:00 Noon
Fourth of July	Christmas Day

\*Covered employees have the ability to work up to three (3) of the designated holidays. In return for working, the individual will be permitted to "float" the holiday.


Holidays falling on a Saturday shall be celebrated on the preceding day. Holidays falling on a Sunday shall be celebrated on the following Monday.

Whenever the Mayor of Stamford or the Board of Representatives declares a day as a holiday, commemorative day, or a day of mourning, it shall be a day off with full pay for the employees covered by this agreement, who are not actually necessary to maintain the good order of the city.
