Please see the attached chart. There may be errors. There was conflicting information in the packet in regards to dates when the Acting Mayor served in the past 10 years. The point was just to get a rough idea of costs. It seems like 30 days per year is a fair estimate for when an Acting Mayor may serve. Of course, extenuating life circumstances (births and deaths of family members), as we are all human, may cause an outlier year. A pandemic would also be the cause for an outlier year.

I calculated costs in the chart for 30 days if we use per diem salary calculated by payroll. That would be about \$23,000 a year. If we use mayor's salary divided by 365 times 30, you get roughly \$16,000.
