The existing Ordinance prohibits the construction of spouts or drains which cause a runoff of water onto sidewalks. The purpose of the Amendment is to add roadways to the prohibitions of the Ordinance, as the runoff of water onto City roadways can create icing hazards in cold weather and may cause damage to asphalt paving.

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 214-9 REGARDING DISCHARGE OF DRAINWATER UPON SIDEWALKS AND ROADWAYS

WHEREAS, Code of Ordinances Section 214-9 prohibits any person from discharging drainwater upon sidewalks; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a related issue as to property owners discharging drainwater upon roadways, which can create icing hazards in cold weather and which may cause damage to the asphalt paving of public roadways; and,

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interests of the safety and general welfare of the citizens of Stamford for the City to regulate the discharge of drainwater upon roadways;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 214-9 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 214-9. Discharge of drainwater upon sidewalks and roadways.

No person shall construct or cause to be constructed or allow to remain any spout or drain from any building or any drainage or runoff from any driveway or premises in such a manner that water, soil, gravel or other debris therefrom will discharge upon and over any sidewalk or roadway within the city.

## BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be take effect immediately on approval.
