Sec. 214-19. - Permit for placing building materials on streets.<sup>[9]</sup>

- A. Any person intending to undertake construction, alteration or repair of any building or other structure upon or adjacent to any public highway may be granted a permit by the Director of Operations, or the designee of said director, to occupy a portion of such highway for building materials, accessories or any other needs specifically related to construction under such terms and conditions as the City Engineer may specify with regard to building construction requirements, and the Office of Operations may specify with regard to the needs of traffic and parking.
- B. The fee for such permit shall be one hundred (\$100.), and such permit shall be valid for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days. Said permit may be renewable upon the filing of another fee of one hundred dollars (\$100).
