RESOLUTION Establishing Fees as Provided by Section 214-29:

Whereas significant direct and indirect administrative costs are incurred by the City of Stamford in order to ensure that private contractor or utility company work on streets and sidewalks is properly performed and that streets and sidewalks are restored to satisfactory condition after work is completed, the following administrative fees are enacted as permitted by Stamford Code of Ordinances section 214-29 and as authorized by Section C2-10-2 of the City Charter:

Normal road or sidewalk work or excavation permit (90 days)	\$250 per permit
Special Excavation Permit for work on road or sidewalk last paved or substantially reconstructed within 60 months	\$500 per permit
Extension of road or sidewalk work permit (90 days)	\$250 per permit extension
Permit for repair/restoration of road or sidewalk which does not pass City inspection within 30 days of completion of work	\$250 per permit
Permit for correction of temporary or permanent patch or restoration within 6 years after the expiration of most recent permit, where City determines there is a patch or restoration deficiency that requires correction by the permittee	\$250 per permit
Failure to obtain any required permit(s)	\$250 per violation in addition to required permit fees
City completion of work pursuant to Section 214-29 E	\$250 in addition to City costs

These fees shall take effect upon the first of the month following enactment.
