## RESOLUTION NO. 3895 ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR STREET OR SIDEWALK OPENING PERMITS, SPECIAL EXCAVATION PERMITS AND OTHER FEES AS PROVIDED BY CODE SECTION 214-29

WHEREAS, significant direct and indirect administrative costs are incurred by the City of Stamford in issuing excavation permits; and

WHEREAS, the Operations Committee of the 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Representatives considered the proposed fees at its February 27, 2018 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Operations Committee of the Board of Representatives held a public hearing and met and approved the following fees on April 23, 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Representatives, pursuant to and within the limitations of Sec. C2-10-2(6) of the Charter of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve the following administrative fees, as permitted by Sec. 214-29 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances effective June 1, 2018.

## STREET AND SIDEWALK EXCAVATION PERMIT FEES

Normal road or sidewalk work or excavation permit (90 days)	\$250 per permit
Special Excavation Permit for work on road or sidewalk last paved or substantially reconstructed within 60 months	\$500 per permit
Extension of road or sidewalk work permit (90 days)	\$250 per permit extension
Permit for repair/restoration of road or sidewalk which does not pass City inspection within 30 days of completion of work	\$250 per permit
Permit for correction of temporary or permanent patch or restoration within 6 years after the expiration of most recent permit, where City determines there is a patch or restoration deficiency that requires correction by the permittee	\$250 per permit
Failure to obtain any required permit(s)	\$250 per violation in addition to required permit fees
City completion of work pursuant to Section 214-29.E	\$250 in addition to City costs

These fees shall take effect on the first of the month following enactment of this Resolution
