A product that contains (1) Glyphosate; (2) 2,4-D; (3) 1,3-D; (4) Neonicotinoids; or (5) Chlorpyrifos may also be used where at the time of the passage of the ordinance, such product is used as part of an existing protocol to control an invasive species.
