 - C. Sold to a third party or parties under current R-MF Zoning;
 - D. Sold to a third party or parties under R-H Zoning;
 - E. Developed into the City's new headquarters for EMS, 911 dispatch, and central fire department;
 - F. Developed into a City facility to operate its youth program; or
 - G. Other suggestions by members of the Board or the public.
